Key Vocabulary		Through playing un-tuned instruments:	
<p>Rhythm - follows the pattern of words, it is often different to the pulse</p> <p>Un-tuned instrument- An un-tuned instrument cannot produce a specific pitch. Such as bass drum, bongo drum, cymbal, gong and snare drum.</p> <p>Pulse – the steady beat</p> <p>Solo – to sing or play on your own</p> <p>Unison – to sing or play the same part altogether</p> <p>Compose – to create a piece of music</p> <p>Texture – the layers of music</p> <p>Ostinato – a repeated rhythm pattern</p>		<p>I can play a variety of un-tuned instruments: tappers, shakers, scrapers and bells</p> <div data-bbox="1128 309 1234 389"></div> <div data-bbox="1288 309 1393 389"></div> <div data-bbox="1433 288 1585 389"></div> <div data-bbox="1619 300 1733 389"></div> <p>I can play un-tuned instruments in a variety of ways: tap shake scrape</p> <p>I can read a four beat notation and play it on my un-tuned instrument.
