### Early Years Dell Farm Visit

We have arranged for our pupils to visit Dell Farm to take part in a range of Christmas activities, each class will be visiting on a different day.

Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> December – Bumblebees and half of Butterflies

Monday 11<sup>th</sup> December – Dragonflies and half of Butterflies

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £8.50 per child to help towards the cost of the trip. Pupils who are entitled to pupil premium will not be required to pay. Your contribution towards the cost of school activities is essential. Without your support, we may not be able to work with external educators outside of school, which provide a varied and fun opportunity for our children to learn. If there is not sufficient money the trip will have to be cancelled.

All pupils will need to wear jogging bottoms or jeans. They should, however, wear school jumpers and shirts. Sensible outdoor shoes (trainers) and wellington boots, which should be clearly named, these should be brought to school in a named plastic bag.

Your child will also need to wear a warm coat, gloves, hat and scarf. All these items must be clearly named.

Pupils will be eating a packed lunch provided by the school so there is no need to provide this for your child.
