In Science, we'll be finding out:

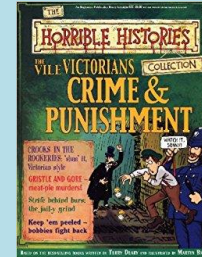
- About Teeth and Eating
