In English, we'll be finding out:

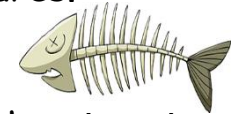
- We will be reading, writing and innovating the story 'Not now Bernard!'

- predicting the best material to use for a boat.

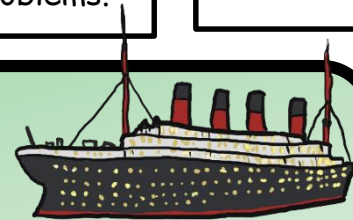


In Technology, we'll be finding out:
