Overview and facts:		Useful websites/links and app suggestions to support your child at home:	
<p><u>'We are painters'</u></p> <p>We will be learning to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -use technology to create, store and retrieve digital content. -recognise common uses of Information Technology beyond school. -use technology safely and sensibly. <p>This unit will appeal particularly to children who love to look at the illustrations in the books they read. It is a great opportunity for the children to work creatively.</p> <p>The learning will be broken into two key areas:</p> <p>Programming</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A set of instructions or rules programmed into a computer is known as an algorithm and your child may be encouraged to use this term when programming. • In addition to this, the term debug might be used when a programming mistake has been identified and is being corrected. <p>Data</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your child will learn where and how to save their work in order to retrieve it again. Typing skills will also be taught to increase speed and accuracy. • Children will learn to refer to information as data. 		Why not try this at home:	
		<p>Why not use a paint program to make a picture for a book you have been reading, or even some poetry you have written?</p> <p>A paint program could be used to illustrate the work children are doing at school. For example, in science they could create a picture of a flower and add text labels to the different parts.</p>	
		E-safety:	
		<p>We teach the children to be SMART online:</p> <p>S – Stay Safe: Don't give out your personal information to people/places you don't know.</p> <p>M – Don't Meet Up: Meeting someone you have only been in touch with online can be dangerous. Always check with an adult you trust.</p> <p>A – Accepting Files: Accepting emails, files, pictures or texts from people you don't know can cause problems.</p> <p>R – Reliable? Check information before you believe it. Is the person or website telling the truth?</p> <p>T – Tell Someone: Tell an adult if someone or something makes you feel worried or uncomfortable.</p>
