In English, we'll be:

- Learning how to write a recount using informal letters.
- Using the story about 'The Day the Crayons Came Home' to look at different types of informal letters to help us create our own.
- Performing a poem called 'Rain in the City' as well as creating our own poems.
- Looking at and analysing a selection of poems, looking at the features and structures of the poems.

In Maths, we'll be:

- Learning about length, looking at millimetres, centimetres and metres.
- Learning how to find the perimeter of specific spaces or shapes.
- Deepening our knowledge of fractions.
- Learning about mass and capacity, as well as comparing within each unit of measure.

In Physical Education (PE), we'll be:

- Learning orienteering, we will learn how to identify objects on a map, learn the eight compass points and use them effectively, use features on a map to help navigate and to plan a route.
- Learning basketball skills. This includes how to hold a basketball, the rules of the games and how to push, throw and catch the ball effectively.

In Personal, Social and Health Education (PSHE), we'll be:

- Exploring the topic of "Celebrating Difference"
- We will be looking at how everyone is different and that everyone should be celebrated for their uniqueness.
- We will be looking at how we can include everyone in our community by celebrating their differences.
