Omnipresent - being present everywhere

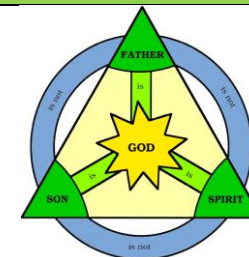

Important Facts

Christians, Jews and Muslims are monotheistic, which means they only believe in one **God**

Christians believe that God has three forms or persons, known as the Holy Trinity. (Trinity meaning three). God the Father, God the Son (Jesus who took human form at Christmas) and God the Holy Spirit.(who we learn about during Pentecost)



What is God like?



For Christians "God is love" (John 4:8) compassionate, all knowing (omniscient), everywhere at once (omnipresent), all powerful (almighty), pure, set apart (holy). Christians believe that it matters what people do. When people treat others badly (sin) it makes God upset and angry.

This tells Jews and Christians more about God and creation – that he is great, creative, concerned with creation, creation is important and how man is important within this as it was made for us.



Atheist beliefs

Many atheists argue that religions are all created by humans. Some argue that there is no need to use a Creator to explain the existence of the Universe and life; they argue that science provides reliable evidence and explanations, and that religion does not. Stephen Hawking was a famous scientist and an atheist.
