
What is the Phonics Screening Check?


- A statutory word-reading test at the end of Year 1
- Children read 40 words
- 20 are real words
- 20 are 'alien' words
- This will take place on the second week of Summer 2 term (June 9th)
- You will be notified if your child passes the PSC
- If your child does not pass, they will need to retake when they are in Year 2


