












Year 1 Home Learning tasks - (Summer 1).

<p>Draw someone or something you love - it could be a family member, a friend, a pet, or a place that makes you happy.</p> 	<p>Make a weather chart. Draw a weather symbol and write what the weather is like each day. Is there a pattern?</p> 	<p>Identify and make a list of all the members of your family.</p> 
<p>Speak to your parents and grandparents. Find out about the toys they played with when they were children.</p> 	<p>Write a fact file about summer. Describe the weather and how to stay safe in the sun.</p> 	<p>Draw a circle and a square and colour in half of each shape.</p> 
<p>Create a collage picture of the very hungry caterpillar.</p> 	<p>Name the 4 seasons and write the months of the year that each season falls in.</p> 	<p>Create a timeline of your life – at one end add 'being born' and at the other end 'now'. Add the events 1st day in reception and 1st day in year one, in chronological order.</p>
<p>Go on a nature walk. Can you spot any evergreen trees? Write about why they are evergreen and describe their leaves.</p> 	<p>How many socks can you find in your house? Practise counting in 2s to find the total.</p> 	<p>Learn and name your left and right hand.</p>
