


<b>Feathers</b>	Soft and light parts of a bird that grows from the skin and covers the body		Fish live in the water; they have <b>gills</b> so that they can breathe underwater. Fish have <b>scaly</b> skin and <b>fins</b> to help them to swim.	
<b>Wings</b>	A pair of movable body parts used by birds, bats, or insects to fly.		Common fish – trout, salmon, tuna, mackerel Fish we might have as pets – goldfish, koi fish	
<b>Beaks</b>	The hard, curved mouth part of a bird		<b>Amphibians</b>	
<b>Fur</b>	The fine, soft, thick, hairy coat of the skin of a mammal		Amphibians live on land and in water, they begin their lives with gills but then develop lungs and breathe on land. they have soft skin and lay their eggs in the water.

			Most birds can fly they have wings, feathers and beaks.	
			Common birds – robin, eagle, owl, penguin Birds we might have as pets – budgie, pigeon, parrot

			Common mammals – tiger, bear, elephant monkey Mammals we might have as pets – hamster, dog, cat	





