Can they match it to the correct picture on the right-hand side?		<p><b>Grammar</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The abbreviation <b>no.</b> is used as a number label in both English and French (e.g. <b>no. 1</b>). It comes from the Latin word <i>numero</i>.</li> <li>The <b>ligature œ</b> as in 'Sacré-Cœur' is known as "σ e stuck together". It occurs in French words such as <b>cœur</b> (heart) or <b>sœur</b> (sister). Ligatures used to be included in English words such as phoenix or foetus, but their use has fallen out of favour and they are rarely seen in current written English.</li> <li>In French, just like in English, the names of monuments and landmarks are written with capital letters, e.g. the <b>Eiffel Tower</b> = la <b>Tour Eiffel</b>.</li> <li>In French, we use a <b>comp</b> after the fronted adverbial, e.g. <b>In Paris</b>, there is the river Seine. <b>À Paris</b>, il y a la Seine.</li> </ul> <p><b>Pronunciation</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The grapheme <b>i</b> is pronounced as long 'ee' (see, meet, etc.). <b>Il y a...</b> (There is/are), <b>aussi</b> (as well/too), <b>à Paris</b> (in Paris).</li> </ul>
