<p><b>Grammar</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A <b>cognate</b> is a word in one language that is related in origin to a word in another language, for example: un parc (a park), un cinéma (a cinema), orange (orange). They have similar spelling, they sound almost the same and they have the same meaning.</li> <li>In French, nouns are divided into 2 categories: masculine and feminine. In French, all nouns have a <b>gender</b>, in English they do not. In French, the determiner must match the gender of the noun that it introduces. The indefinite article is <b>un</b> with masculine nouns, and <b>une</b> with feminine.</li> <li>When an adjective describes a noun, the <b>adjective must agree with the gender of the noun</b>. When an adjective describes <i>a feminine noun</i>, it must agree by adding an 'e', unless it already ends in an 'e'.</li> <li>The French <b>pronoun 'je'</b> is the equivalent of the English pronoun 'I'.</li> <li>When a sentence begins with a fronted adverbial, it needs to be followed by a comma, just like in English, e.g. <u>Dans le jardin</u>, il y a une abeille. <u>In the garden</u>, there is a ladybird.</li> </ul> <p><b>Pronunciation</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In English, the grapheme 'oi' is pronounced as in oil, boil and soil. In French, it is pronounced [w], as in poisson, bois, trois and étoile.</li> <li>If a word ends with an -e without an accent, then that e will be silent, e.g. une abeille, une coccinelle, une étoile.</li> </ul>
