





<p><b>Pulse</b>– the steady beat felt throughout the music. <i>You might tap your toe in time with the music.</i></p> <p><b>Rhythm</b> – follows the pattern of words. It is often different to the pulse. <i>You can clap the rhythm of the words.</i></p>		 <p><b>Remember – this song builds up.</b> The leader stands with the team of penguins in front of them. After singing once, the leader instructs the 'penguins' what to do. Each time, the new movement is added to the previous ones until the children are moving both arms, both legs and head while they sing.</p> <p><b>ACTIONS:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) RIGHT ARM</li> <li>2) LEFT ARM</li> <li>3) RIGHT LEG</li> <li>4) LEFT LEG</li> <li>5) HEAD</li> </ol>


