


<p><u>'We are opinion pollsters'</u></p> <p>In this unit, you will create your own opinion poll, seek responses, and then analyse the results. The main focus of the unit is on collecting, analysing and presenting data, and the opportunity to evaluate some data. Because you will be working online, the unit also helps to develop your understanding of the Internet and the world wide web. You will also learn more about using the internet safely, responsibly and respectfully as you design surveys that comply with the law (by not storing data that can identify different people).</p> <p>By the end of term you will enable you to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • understand how to design a survey • understand some legal parts of online data collection • use the web to facilitate (help with) data collection • gain skills in using charts to analyse (examine) data • gain skills in interpreting results. <p>Much of the work, and fun, is looking for examples of surveys in the media, particularly if they are of interest to you.
