<p><b>Control tower</b> - a tall building at an airport from which the movements of air traffic are controlled.</p> <p><b>Terminal</b>- building at an airport where passengers go to when a flight arrives or departs.</p> <p><b>EasyJet</b> - An airline company limited.</p> <p><b>Ryanair</b> - Irish low cost airline.</p> <p><b>Lounge</b> - Place where passengers can sit, wait and relax.</p> <p><b>Duty Free</b> - goods that are exempt from payment of duty.</p> <p><b>Trophy</b> - cup or other decorative object awarded as a prize for a victory.</p> <p><b>Hatters</b> - Nickname for Luton Town football club.</p> <p><b>Football league</b> - A league competition involving professional football Clubs.</p> <p><b>Logo</b> - A symbol or a small design.</p>	<p>London Luton airport was officially opened on 16<sup>th</sup> July 1938. During the war the airport was used as a base for fighter squadrons. In 1952 the airport started to be used by the public and a new control tower was built.</p> <p>In 1985 a new international terminal building was built. Luton airport has one terminal and one lounge known as the beautiful Aspire Executive Lounge.</p> <p>Since the 1990s there have been many improvements the extension and refurbishment of the passenger terminal, new access road, a new extension to the car park.</p> <p>Wide range of shops and restaurants have been opened. EasyJet, Ryanair, are the main low cost airlines that use Luton Airport. Charter airlines like, TUI airways, Wizz Air, and Thomas Cook offer a great selection of holiday flights.</p> <p>End of 1999 a new rail track opened a London Luton Parkway station, which made quick and easy links to London.</p> <p>Luton Town football club known as the Hatters, it reflects Luton's connection to the hat industry.</p> <p>The team plays its home matches on Kenilworth Road. The most prominent years for Luton Town football club was between 1982 and 1992.</p> <p>Luton team won their first major trophy. Luton played against Arsenal at London Wembley Stadium in 1988 and won the football league cup. Luton's Football kit has changed over the years. The colour of the home kit is orange.</p> <p>.</p>
