

<p>Go for a walk to the park and record how many different types of transport you see. E.g. How many buses, aeroplanes, bikes, fire engines?</p>	<p>Have a go at writing some cvc words e.g. cat, dog, hat, mat, tip, bat, sad. Or: Have a go at writing short sentences e.g. The cat is on the mat. (Remember your capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.</p>	<p>Have a go at working out some addition and subtraction calculations. E.g. $4+2=$ or $6-3=$ Use objects to help you work it out and record your number sentence and answer.</p>
<p>Tell us about a journey you have been on. For example, have you been on an aeroplane, a bus or a train? Where did you go? How long did it take? Maybe you could stick in a photo of you on your journey.</p>	<p>Practise counting to 20 and looking for numbers whilst out and about e.g. on doors, around the house, on buses. Draw pictures/ stick photos to show us where you found them!</p>	<p>Explore junk modelling! You could make a vehicle such as a fire engine with a ladder, a boat, a bus, a rocket or a train. Please decorate it and bring it in to show us.</p> 
<p>Cook at home/ help your parents create your favourite or traditional dish (take a photo and stick in your book)</p> 	<p>Go on a journey to your local library. Maybe you could choose some books to share at home and draw pictures/ label the main characters. E.g. Supertato or The Gruffalo.</p>	<p>Explore rhyming words e.g. cat, mat, bat. Can you write a list of words that rhyme? You could even write some sentences with rhyming words in. e.g. The cat sat on the mat.</p>
<p>Can you write the numbers 0-20 independently and in the correct order?</p>	<p>Draw a picture of your favourite tv programme or book character. Please tell us why they are your favourite.</p>	<p>Show or tell us about your hobbies. Do you have any certificates, photos or medals you could bring in and show us?</p>
