It took three years to build. • Titanic first journey was from Southampton to New York. • It carried 2223 passengers. • Titanic did not reach its destination as it hit an iceberg. • The Titanic sank in the North Atlantic Ocean on April 15th 1912. • There were not enough lifeboats on board to hold all the passengers. • Titanic's First class passengers were for the rich and upper class. • Second class was similar to first Class. • Third Class was less luxurious. The third class passengers were not allowed to go to second or first class.
