Lesson 1: Tuesday 11th June 2019

Learning Intention

To introduce the concept of male and female and gender stereotypes.

To identify differences between males and females.

Learning Outcomes

Understand that some people have fixed ideas about what boys and girls can do.

Describe the difference between male and female babies.

Lesson 2: Tuesday 11th June 2019

Learning Intention

To explore some of the differences between males and females and to understand how this is part of lifecycle.

Learning Outcomes

Describe some differences between male and female animals.

Understand that making a new life needs a male and a female.

Lesson 3: Thursday 13th June 2019

Learning Intention

To focus on sexual difference and name body parts

Learning Outcomes

Describe the physical differences between males and females.

Name the male and female body parts.

Parents do not have the right to withdraw their children from the relationship element nor from the science National Curriculum which covers some parts of animal (including human) and plant reproduction.
