#### Year 4 Otter/Fox swimming lessons for summer term

We have been able to arrange another term of swimming lessons for our year four children. Lessons will commence on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> April and the last lesson will be Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> July.

Swimming is an important expectation of the National Curriculum, firstly helping the children learn how to swim and secondly enabling them to achieve higher levels of proficiency-in many cases developing a fine leisure activity for the future. All children are expected to participate unless they have a medical reason that prevents them, and a medical certificate must be provided.

Girls require a one-piece swimming costume and long hair must be tied back or a swimming hat worn. Boys require a pair of trunks/ lycra shorts which must be worn above the knee and close fitting to avoid drag (the pool does not permit shorts). No jewellery at all may be worn and watches and earrings should be left at home on swimming days.

The children also require a towel and plastic bag for wet items.

Please make sure you label all of the items with your child's name and class. The children are discouraged from bringing body creams, talcum powder etc.

The cost for the whole of the summer term will be £36.60, and this can be paid in full or £3.05 per week. Payment can be made via the office or online using scopay. Please note that refunds are only possible where reasons exclude your child for four or more consecutive weeks and medical certificates must have been provided.

I am aware of the demands made on families and would not wish to put any undue pressure on your resources. Please come and see me if you wish to discuss this further.
