


<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Amelia Earhart was the first female pilot to fly alone across the Atlantic Ocean. • She was an American pilot. • She bought her first plane in 1921 and called it the Canary. 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ernest Shackleton was a sailor from Ireland. • He wanted to be the first person to reach the South Pole. • He tried to get to the South Pole four times but was unsuccessful all four times. 	

- 1932 – she became the first woman to fly solo across the Atlantic.
- Amelia began an adventure to fly around the world, but she and her navigator Fred went missing.
