Re: Healthy Child Programme for School-aged Children – Year R

The School Nursing Service will be commencing their routine visits to schools as part of the Healthy Child Programme.

At this school-based visit, the team will complete vision screening for your child. These might be done on separate days to comply with COVID restrictions within schools.

You will be informed of the results of your child's Vision Screening via letter, only if follow-up is required or if there is a concern. However, ALL results will be recorded onto your child's electronic health records, which can be seen by your GP and other health professionals.

- If you are happy for the School Nursing team to see your child, you do not need to do anything.
- If you do not want your child to be seen in school, please email us on ccs.bedsandlutonchildrenshealthhub@nhs.net within 1 week.
- If your child wears glasses or attends an eye clinic or sees an optometrist, please inform us via email at ccs.bedsandlutonchildrenshealthhub@nhs.net within 1 week as we will not test their vision in school.

The School Nursing Service can offer advice and support for a range of physical, developmental, and emotional health needs. If you require help with any of the following:

- Your child has any health issues or needs which require support in school such as asthma, allergies or epilepsy

If you would like support please contact the 0-19 Single Point of Access on the above telephone number, the administrator will ask for your child's name, date of birth and the school they attend so they can identify the school nurse team in your area, who will return your call within 2 working days.
