Dear parent / carer,

Year 4 will be going on a Viking Trail at St Alban's Cathedral on Wednesday 12th October 2022.

We have chosen this trip to complement our Viking studies in our history lessons this half term. We will also be participating in a Saxon food workshop, run by the Cathedral Education Centre.

The trip will take place from 9am – 3pm. The children will leave school at 9 am after registration. They will be traveling by coach, accompanied by members of staff. Children will need to arrive in school wearing their school uniform but will not need their school bags. Pupils will also need to bring a packed lunch, a water bottle and a school jumper for the day. We endeavour to be back at school for 3pm, traffic permitting.

We are asking for £18.86 per child towards travel and entry expenses (£10.36 for the coach and £8.50 for the Trail). You can either pay via Scopay or by card (no cash please), at the school office. Pupils who are entitled to pupil premium will not need to contribute. Your contribution to the cost of the trip is essential. Without your support, we may not be able to offer such a valuable learning experience outside of school. In the event that we do not receive enough funds we may need to cancel.
