



Year 6 – Visit to Duxford Imperial War Museum

Dear Parents and carers

This autumn term, pupils in Year 6 are learning about The Second World War. As part of our learning, we will be visiting Duxford Imperial War Museum in Cambridge. The trip will take place on **Tuesday 17th October 2023**.

During the day, pupils will have the opportunity to explore the artefacts on display; hear from experts; and engage with an interactive workshop: Documentary Challenge. Documentary Challenge takes students out of the classroom and into IWM's galleries to explore objects and tell stories in their own words. Pupils will be given smart-cameras and tasked with making mini documentaries, developing historical inquiry skills to question, consider, debate and evaluate primary sources. Through the activity, we hope that pupils will gain a deeper understanding of the impact of war and conflict on people's lives in the past, and its relevance in society today.

We are asking for a contribution of £15.50 per child, to cover the cost of the return coach journey and the workshop.
