Competitions

Photo competition — Children are invited to take photographs around the theme of Nature and Climate, this could be: the weather, animals and plants, light, forces and magnet etc. Please send your photo with your child's name and class to Science.Comp@riverbankprimary.org. There will be a prize for the best photo taken within each year group. All entries must be submitted by Thursday 29th February.

Poster competition — This year's science week theme is 'TIME'. Children could create a poster showing how technology has changed over time, time telling, how things might look or work in the future, lifecycles, lifespans, evolution, hibernation, the seasons etc. This must be completed on paper no bigger than A4. The top 5 entries across the school will receive a prize and also be entered into the British Science Week Poster Competition 2024.
