



Dear parents/ carers

This autumn term, pupils in Year 6 are learning about The Second World War. As part of our learning, we will be visiting London's Royal Air Force Museum. The trip will take place on Tuesday **11th November** for **Oak and Elm** class, and **Wednesday 12th November** for **Ash and Hazel** class.

During the day, pupils will have the opportunity to explore the artefacts on display, hear from experts, and engage with an interactive workshop: 'Air Raid!'. As part of the workshop, pupils will travel back to 1940 to explore what life was like on the Home Front and meet an Air Raid Warden who will encourage pupils to stay safe during blackouts, gas attacks and air raids. Through this workshop, we hope that classroom learning will be brought to life, supporting pupils to gain a deeper understanding of the impact of war on children, and therefore develop their creative writing linked to the topic.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £12.67 per child, to cover the cost of the return coach journey and the workshop. This **must be paid by Wednesday 22nd October 2025**. This trip is free of charge to pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium.

Please ensure your child arrives at school punctually at 8:45 on the day of the trip as we plan to leave school at 9am. We then aim to arrive back to school for 15:15. Extended day will go ahead as normal on Wednesday 12th November.

If your child is eligible to receive free school meals, lunch will be provided. Otherwise, please ensure your child brings a labelled packed lunch for the trip.
