



Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to inform you about an exciting update to the way we use knowledge organisers across our school to further support your child's learning. This change is designed to strengthen vocabulary development, deepen subject knowledge and help improve long term memory.

Knowledge organisers have already been used in lessons to support children with key facts, concepts and subject specific vocabulary. Moving forward, we would like to expand their use so that they also support learning at home. This includes encouraging discussions with your child about what they are learning, as well as self-quizzing and parent-led quizzing using the knowledge organisers. These activities help children recall and embed information, supporting their confidence and understanding.

Knowledge organisers will now also form part of your child's homework. Homework tasks may include completing the creative activities included on the knowledge organiser itself or filling in the knowledge and vocabulary grids provided by the class teacher. Both approaches offer meaningful opportunities for pupils to practise and revisit their learning.
